<b>English</b>	Write a postcard from a zoo or park visit. Remember to include 'Dear' at the start of your postcard.	Write your own animal poem using similes. Remember to use the words 'like' or 'as' in your simile e.g. the bear's tummy was as fluffy as a cloud.	Write an information page about your favourite animal. You can choose how you are going to present your information.	Write your own Wishing Tale. Remember your main character needs to wish that they have something, they have a problem getting it but in the end solve the problem and their wish comes true.	Create your own brochure for Woburn Safari Park, attracting people to go there. Make sure it is bright and exciting.
<b>Maths</b>	Practise a times table(s) of your choice, writing it out in full. Try to challenge yourself! Now write the corresponding division facts.	Create your very own shape animal. You are only allowed to use 2D shapes. Label your drawing, showing which shapes you have used.	Choose 6 objects around your home and measure their mass. Remember to measure in g or kg depending on the object. If you do not have any scales you could estimate the mass of your objects.	Write your own price list for things that you might be able to buy at the zoo. Choose 3 items and find out how much it would cost in total. Ext: how much change would you get from £20?	Write your own addition and subtraction problems to challenge your teacher.
<b>Theme</b>	Draw and label the different parts of a plant of your choice.	Draw what you can see out of your window on a sunny day. Make careful observations and make your drawings detailed using the sketching skills learnt on our wow days.	Carry out a mini-beast hunt either in your garden or at a park near you. You can either draw what you have found or create a tally chart to show your results.	Create your very own new animal. It could be part of one animal and part of another. Give your animal a name and describe its habitat and what it eats.	Using the skills learnt last term create your own moving animal or plant picture. You can choose which mechanism to use such as a slide, level or wheel.

- **Contractions** can't, didn't, hasn't, couldn't, it's, I'll
- **Word ending in –tion** station, fiction, motion, national, section
