Provision:

Maths Support

- Specialist tuition to provide focused intervention.
- Two additional maths groups in years 5 and 6 to reduce teaching groups and therefore target children more effectively.
- Monitoring of 'in-class' provision for all Pupil Premium children by Senior Leadership Team.

Reading and Writing Support

- Fresh Start and Read, Write Inc. Interventions to accelerate progress in Literacy.
- Additional Literacy groups in years 5 and 6 to reduce teaching groups and therefore target children more effectively.
- Monitoring of 'in-class' provision for all Pupil Premium children by Senior Leadership Team.
- Intervention groups to support children with specific learning needs to support reading and writing.

Pupil Well-being and Learning Support

- Funding a school Learning Mentor / Family Support worker to support targeted children and families.
- Support for extra-curricular activities such as before and after-school clubs, residential trips and visits.
- Providing places at breakfast club (Windmill Wide Awake Club) and an After School Provision (from February 2016) to ensure quality 'wrap-around' care.
- We have sought external organisations and identified opportunities for children to have an enriched and enhanced experience of the curriculum. Investigate projects in mathematics, artistic and musical performances, sporting experiences are just a few of the curriculum enrichment areas we focused on this year.
- Parenting support through the facilitating (and subsidising) of positive parenting courses such as 123 Magic and 'Help I'm a Parent'.
- Programmes of child support from external agencies such as Play Therapy and VIG.
- Providing support through ICT software and hardware.
