Dear Parents/Carers,

This year for Children In Need we will be allowing the children to take control. Each child will need to donate £1 towards the charity and they can then come to school in Mufti (Children in Need related Mufti is welcome). Each class will then have control over their teacher and teaching assistant for 10 minutes in the morning and 10 minutes in the afternoon and will be able to decide on a new rule...

eg. The teacher needs to walk like a chicken around the classroom.

In addition to this, in each class children are encouraged to do their own Children In Need challenge at home and to raise money. This may be a readathon, cake sale, sponsored silence... anything that you decide is practical. Money will then need to be brought into school so that it can be totalled and sent to the charity. The child who raises the most money in each class doing their own personal challenge outside of school will be able to become a member of SLT for 10 minutes at the start of the day, 10 minutes at the start of lunch and 10 minutes in the afternoon. This could mean that they sit in Mr. Colemans office eating biscuits!

The children In Need challenges in school will take place on Friday 17th November. For children doing their own challenges, the money will need to be brought into their class teachers no later than Thursday 16th November so that the new members of SLT can be decided.
