In our theme Awesome Authors, we will be finding out about the author, illustrator and artist Oliver Jeffers. We will be finding out about his life, what inspires him to create his wonderful stories and the range of techniques he uses to illustrate his books. We will then use what we find to help us as we become authors and illustrators. We will also of course be reading and sharing a wide range of his stories from *Lost and Found* to *The Heart and the Bottle*.



Our Art for this term will help us to explore and understand the books further, and we will be developing our skills using watercolours and collage.

Our Science this term will be looking at working scientifically and healthy eating.

English

In English, we will be creating our very own picture books. We will focus on a story called *The Incredible Book Eating Boy* and use this to help us to create our own warning tale. We will be using persuasion to convince our readers to stay safe from the perils in the world. We will also be writing our very own 'About the Author' section to complete our picture book as well as the blurb to entice our readers to read it.



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Each term a set of spellings will go home with your child on the back of the home learning grids. Please support your child with learning these as they will help develop their written work. Your child can also access the Spelling shed website.

Reading

We will be listening to the children read at least twice a week in school, as well as during Read, Write Inc. lessons. Please listen to your child read as often as possible and make a note of it in their reading record book. Each time your child reads and it is record in their reading record book, they will get a raffle ticket, which will go into a monthly prize draw.


Maths

In maths, we will be continuing to develop our knowledge of place value to 50 and we will be exploring multiples of 2, 5 and 10. We will be using all of our skills to explain our answers and problem solve. It would be great if you could support your children by practising counting in 2s, 5s and 10s at home. We will also be concentrating on developing our knowledge of measures, focusing on measuring length and height, weight and volume.

Times tables

Please support your child with the learning of their times tables. For children in Year 1, it would be useful if they can recall facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times tables.
